## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On January 22, 2020, B-Petro Corporation (B-Petro) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal (Mot.), which concerns a leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 306 North Canal in Annawan, Henry County. B-Petro had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) in which the Agency modified B-Petro's amended site investigation budget and B-Petro's actual costs budget for Stage 2 and Stage 3 site investigation for the leaking UST site. B-Petro's motion states that "the parties have been able to resolve their disagreements" and that B-Petro "no longer seeks to appeal the Respondent's UST decision." Mot. at 1.

The Board grants B-Petro's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
