ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On March 20, 2009, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) issued a renewed Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit with conditions to Holland Energy, LLC (Holland Energy) for its natural gas-fired power plant facility located at Rural Route 2, 270-A, Beecher City, Shelby County. On April 24, 2009, Holland Energy petitioned the Board for review of specified conditions in the renewed CAAPP permit. The renewal permit was stayed as of the filing of the petition, and the prior permit remained in effect until the Board rules on the merits of the petition or Holland voluntarily dismisses the petition. Holland Energy, LLC v. IEPA, PCB 09-96, slip op. at 1 (May 7, 2009).

On December 19, 2019, the Board granted the parties' joint motion (Mot.) to lift the stay of uncontested permit conditions and remand the permit to IEPA while retaining jurisdiction. The joint motion stated that the parties had negotiated an agreement concerning the contested permit conditions. Mot. at 1. The joint motion added that, when IEPA issued a modified permit incorporating the negotiated changes, Holland Energy would move to dismiss this appeal. *Id.* at 2.

On February 7, 2020, Holland Energy filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss its appeal. The Board grants the unopposed motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
