ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

The letter of July 31, 1974 asking a change in the conditions of PCB 73-261 Wadell Brooks, Sr. v. EPA, October 12, 1973 shall be docketed as a variance from a Board Order.

The instant petition is inadequate in that the inclusion of the record in PCB 73-261 is not stipulated to. Petitioner shall so stipulate within 45 days from the date of this order and furnish an amended petition with additional information as to the flows to be expected should the variance be granted.

Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing the additional information.
