

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie):

On March 31, 2020, Dixie Travel Plaza filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns an application for payment from the Underground Storage Tank (UST) Fund for Dixie Travel Plaza's leaking UST site located at 501 South Main Street in McLean, McLean County. Dixie Travel Plaza had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency partially denying Dixie Travel Plaza's UST Fund reimbursement request. The Board grants Dixie Travel Plaza's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
