POST HEARING REPLY BRIEF OF METROPOLITAN WATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT OF GREATER CHICAGO

Based on all of the information submitted to date in this rulemaking, MWRD and the other Petitioners have met their burden to show that the requested Time-Limited Water Quality Standard (TLWQS) should be approved by the Board. This reply brief is intended to address one specific issue raised by the environmental groups (filing as River Advocates) in their post-hearing brief, regarding the possibility of increased monitoring beyond the conditions that were proposed in the Joint Petition. This issue was addressed initially in MWRD's Post-Hearing brief, which stated MWRD's commitment to continue certain existing monitoring procedures in the Chicago Area Waterways System (CAWS), and to have this monitoring included as a requirement in the final Board Order approving the TLWQS, subject to certain conditions. In this brief, MWRD provides additional detail concerning these proposed monitoring requirements, including by specifying the locations and frequency for that monitoring. We believe that this proposal addresses the concerns raised by River Advocates in their Post-Hearing Brief.

Currently, MWRD collects chloride data on a monthly basis at 14 stations in the CAWS that are part of its Ambient Water Quality Monitoring (AWQM) program. It also collects data on a weekly basis at one AWQM station, located at Lockport. (These 15 stations are identified as AWQM stations on the attached map.) In addition, MWRD collects conductivity data on an hourly basis at a series of Continuous Dissolved Oxygen Monitoring (CDOM) stations. 9 of these CDOM stations are located near an AWQM station that collects chloride data. (These 9 CDOM stations are identified on the attached map with an asterisk.) For these 9 stations, MWRD can derive hourly chloride estimates, by using the hourly conductivity data, the chloride data from the nearby AWQM stations, and a linear regression model.

MWRD will commit (subject to certain conditions, specified below) to continue conducting those tests and deriving those estimates during the term of the TLWQS, and to include that information in its Annual Report filed under the TLWQS. As stated in MWRD's Post-Hearing Brief, it is important to note that there are some unusual circumstances in which this sampling may not occur. Weather, mechanical issues, or safety issues may prevent sampling. On occasion, a sampling location may need to be moved to a new location, due to construction of a bridge or some other logistical issue, and sampling may need to be reduced temporarily due to extreme financial concerns. MWRD will commit to continuing these tests, and is willing to have the Board include that requirement in its final Order approving the TLWQS, as long as flexibility is provided for those situations (outlined in this paragraph) in which the sampling regimen may need to be modified. We suggest that to implement this commitment, the Board include the following language in its Order:

In its Annual Report, MWRD will include the following information: (1) chloride data that it collects on a monthly basis at 14 stations in the CAWS that are part of

its Ambient Water Quality Monitoring (AWOM) program; (2) chloride data that it

collects on a weekly basis at one AWQM station, located at Lockport; and (3)

hourly chloride estimates, based on conductivity data that it collects on an hourly

basis at 9 Continuous Dissolved Oxygen Monitoring (CDOM) stations. The

relevant AWQM and CDOM stations are indicated on the attached map (with an

asterisk identifying the relevant CDOM stations). This requirement is subject to

the following conditions: Weather, mechanical issues, or safety issues may prevent

sampling; a sampling location may need to be moved to a new location, due to

construction of a bridge or some other logistical issue; and sampling may need to

be reduced temporarily due to extreme financial concerns. If any of those situations

occurs, MWRD shall notify IEPA, and the issue will be noted in the Annual Report.

Summaries of the chloride information provided by MWRD in its Annual Reports

will be included in the Status Reports submitted by the Chloride Workgroups.

MWRD believes that this commitment will provide the information that River Advocates are

requesting concerning chloride levels in various reaches of the CAWS.
