The purpose of this memo is to confirm the agreements that have been reached between Will County and Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. regarding amendments of Laraway Host Agreements. These terms and conditions are subject to the approval of the full Will County Board, as well as Executive Management at Waste Management.

A. Amendment of Laraway Host Agreement

1. <u>Expansion Area</u>. The Host Agreement will be amended to include areas to the north and south of the currently approved Laraway Landfill, as depicted on the attached Exhibit A, as "Laraway Expansion 2."

2. <u>Environmental Enhancement Project</u>. Waste Management agrees to perform a remedial closure of the Olin Ponds as part of the development of Laraway Expansion 2 with all remediation activities conducted in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency.

3. <u>Indemnification/Reimbursement</u>. Waste Management agrees to indemnify and reimburse the County for reasonable and necessary outside attorney fees incurred in connection with the negotiations of the Amendment, consistent with the indemnification/reimbursement provision set forth in Section 4.2 of the Laraway Host Agreement.

4. <u>Host Benefit Fees</u>. Section 5.1 of the Laraway Host Agreement will be revised to increase the per ton fees paid on contaminated soils accepted at Laraway for bio-remediation or landfilling by increasing the per ton host fee for annual volume between 701,000 – 800,000 tons to \$2.25 per ton and for annual volume over 800,001 tons to \$2.75 per ton. These increased amounts, as are all per ton host fees, will be subject to the annual adjustment provision set forth in Section 5.3, with the first adjustment being on January 19, 2015. The effective date for these increases will be the date on which Waste Management achieves final, non-appealable siting approval for Laraway Expansion 2.

5. <u>Annual Payments to the County</u>. Waste Management agrees to pay to the County annual payments of \$100,000 for five years to be used at the County's discretion, with the first payment to be made within thirty (30) days of Waste Management achieving final, non-appealable siting approval for Laraway Expansion 2.

6. <u>Annual Payments to Community Organizations</u>. Waste Management agrees to pay to Will County, for the benefit of community organizations selected by County Board representatives for the District in which the Laraway expansion is located, annual payments aggregating \$50,000 each year for five years, with the first payment to be made within thirty (30) days of Waste Management achieving final, non-appealable siting approval for Laraway Expansion 2.

7. <u>Other Payments to the County</u>. Waste Management agrees to pay to the County \$500,000 within thirty (30) days of its achieving final, non-appealable siting approval for Laraway Expansion 2. Waste Management further agrees to pay \$166,667 within thirty (30) days after any calendar year after it achieves final, non-appealable siting approval during which Waste Management receives at Laraway over 800,000 tons of soils, until such time as a total of an additional \$500,000 is paid to Will County.

8. <u>Other Provisions of Host Agreement</u>. All other provisions of the current Host Agreement, such as compliance with laws, domestic water well protection and the residential property value guarantee program will continue in effect during the period Waste Management operates Laraway Expansion 2.

Thank you for agreeing to meet with Mayor Bob O'Dekirk and me on September 21, 2015 to discuss the proposed expansion of the Will County Landfill. As you are aware, traffic must travel through the City of Joliet to access the Will County Landfill. As indicated in the application, Laraway Road from the western terminus to Route 53 is under the jurisdiction of the City of Joliet. The zoning map provided to you at the meeting verifies the territory within the City of Joliet.

Traffic in the area is of great concern to the City of Joliet. As such, criterion (vi) as set forth in 415 ILCS 5/39.2 (the traffic patterns to or from the facility are so designed as to minimize the impact on existing traffic flows) is exceptionally relevant to the proposed expansion. Traffic is already extremely heavy in the Route 53/Laraway Road area which is due, in part, to traffic to and from the Will County Landfill. An additional average of 1,180 vehicles per day to and from the Will County Landfill will only compound the traffic issues. In addition, the proposed expansion also calls for roll-offs (as opposed to exclusively tractor-trailers) which means even more traffic for the proposed increased tonnage.

Joliet is already significantly impacted by the Will County Landfill due to the amount of traffic. The application indicates an improvement to the intersection of Route 53 and Laraway Road and that said improvements will be completed by 2018; it is unknown who provided said information because there is no set completion date (or even a start-date). Additionally, Laraway Road is only one lane west from Route 53. Future development (including a potential Will County Landfill expansion) will likely necessitate additional lanes on Laraway Road.

Applicants of pollution control facilities commonly enter into "secondary" host agreements with impacted municipalities, especially those municipalities whose roads must be traversed to access a pollution control facility. The City of Joliet is respectfully requesting Waste Management enter into a "secondary" host agreement with the City of Joliet and a host benefit fee of \$0.40/per ton. At this time, the City of Joliet is not requesting Waste Management improve the intersection of Route 53 and Laraway Road or the widening of Laraway Road. If you would like to discuss this matter further, please contact me at (815) 724-3805. As the hearing is approaching, we are requesting a response by October 2, 2015. 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#### Laraway Expansion - Will County Board

#### Project

- Laraway is an environmental remediation project originally approved by this board in January of 2007 and encompasses 871 acres of total property.
- The project includes two types of operations- the solid waste unit 163 acres and the capping of the phosphogypsum stack – 175 acres
- The solid waste unit is designed to meet IEPA subtitle D standards. Includes a HDPE liner, leachate collection system and HDPE liner cap- all the same as your Prairie View site.
- The phosphogypsum stack operation is being capped with bio- remediated soils and clean soils.

#### **New Expansion**

- Solid Waste Unit
- North section is 71 acres remediation of the Olin phosphate ponds
- South section is 24 acres reconfiguration of the southern footprint of the original expansion
- Adds approximately 15 years of capacity to the solid waste unit

#### Steps to Approval

- Negotiate an amendment to the host agreement to include the new property to the north
- File siting application with Will County and conduct public hearings
- File application for construction with IEPA


We had our final negotiations session with Will County's team. Today board leadership was present so there is total buy in to the final offer. The particulars are below.

Upon non-appealable siting of the Laraway Expansion (anticipated in late 2015)

- \$50k for 5 years District 8 needs
- \$100k for 5 years Will County general fund
- \$500k lump sum payment Will County general fund
- \$500k paid in thirds when Laraway reaches 800k in soil intake in any year until paid in full

Soil host fee increases – upon non -appealable siting

- 701k tons to 800k tons WM will pay an additional \$0.28/ton or \$2.25/ton
- 801k tons and up WM will pay an additional \$0.31/ton or \$2.75/ton (2013 soil quantity above 800k = 1,591,893 tons)

Mike I attended the Will County Board meeting today and had the opportunity to speak with Nick Palmer about the Laraway negotiations two issues.

Laraway

I discussed Waste Management's latest position on the amended host agreement negotiations.

- 1. WM agrees to \$50k for 5 years, \$100k for 5 years and \$500k lump sum all on non-appealable siting.
- 2. WM agrees to the county's offer on the remaining \$500k paid out in thirds if the site exceeds 800k tons in any year.
- 3. WM will create two new host fee tiers 900k tons 1M tons and 1M + each at \$0.25 over the existing top tier. This would be paid upon commencement of the expansion or a date certain ( we still need to decide on that date). The date certain is critical to the County's buy-in.
- 4. All of the above must resolve the recycling issue at Prairie View and we must be named operator for any extended life at Prairie View if amended by the Federal Government.

Nick believes these are agreeable but would like to review the additional tiers with me in more detailwe plan to meet Tuesday late afternoon.



*I will keep you posted on our progress on both issues. The next full negotiation date is Wednesday May 21 at 10:30 am.*
