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## BOARD MEETING MINUTES

**October 15, 2020**

### Teleconference

Consistent with the Governor’s Disaster Proclamation of September 18, 2020, issued in response to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, as well as Public Act 101-0640, effective June 12, 2020, the Board conducted this regular open meeting by teleconference.
