ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On April 16, 2014, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Ginger L. Deavers (petitioner) may appeal a March 5, 2014 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency)¹. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency requires modification of the site investigation plan developed to remediate a leaking underground storage tank. The Agency requires modification in order to demonstrate compliance with Sections 57.7(a)(1) and 57.7(c) of the Act (415 ILCS 5/57.7(a), 57.7(c) (2012)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 734.505(b) and 734.510(a)). The incident occurred at petitioner's facility located at 205 Southwest Street in Danvers, McLean County.

The Board extends the appeal period until July 10, 2014, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2012); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If petitioner fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
