**HEARING OFFICER ORDER**

On January 12, 2021, all parties participated in a telephonic conference. Discussions centered on the agreed Supplemental Motions to Correct the Hearing Transcripts filed by Johns Manville (JM) on January 7, 2021. The transcripts in question are the October 28, 2020 and October 29, 2020 hearing transcripts.


Because of the numerous errors found in the transcripts, JM requests that the court reporter listen to the recordings again and correct the transcripts accordingly because the court reporter has transcribed “inaudible” several times and has left out various portions of the hearing entirely. JM attached additional transcript corrections to their supplemental motions and request those to be incorporated as well. JM also requests that the video recordings be supplied to them so they too may listen and review. Finally, JM requests that the uncorrected transcripts of October 28 and 29, 2020, be stricken from the record and supplemented with the corrected transcripts when available to avoid confusion.

On January 11, 2021, the Clerk of the Pollution Control Board emailed correspondence to the court reporter and requested that the court reporter correct the errors in the transcripts and to listen to the video recordings to assist in the corrections. The Clerk attached all the Motions to Correct filed by JM, including the Supplemental Motions filed January 7, 2021. On January 12, 2021, I emailed the parties a link to the video recordings of October 28 and 29, 2020, for their review.

JM’s motions are granted.

Due to the transcript issues, the post-hearing briefing schedule is stayed and will be revisited until corrected transcripts are available.


