ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Van Wie)


On October 7, 2020, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which ExxonMobil Oil Corporation (ExxonMobil) may appeal a September 10, 2020 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2018); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns ExxonMobil’s underground storage tank (UST) site located at 10301 South Cicero Avenue in Oak Lawn, Cook County, Illinois. The Agency rejected ExxonMobil’s Corrective Action Plan submitted for LUST Incidents 912781 & 913646.

On October 15, 2020, the Board extended the appeal period until January 17, 2021. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2018); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. The Board stated “[i]f ExxonMobil fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.”

ExxonMobil did not file an appeal on or before January 17, 2021. Accordingly, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
