

This Opinion constitutes the Board's findings of fact and conclusions of law in this matter.

ORDER

Petitioner Mobil Chemical Company is granted a variance from Rule 408(b) of Chapter 3: Water Pollution for its polymer manufacturing facility in Joliet, subject to the following conditions:

1. This variance will expire on March 31, 1981 or upon adoption of a Final Order modifying Rule 408(b) of Chapter 3 in R76-21, whichever occurs first.
2. During the period of this variance Petitioner shall not discharge more than 15,000 pounds per day of total dissolved solids.
3. The Agency, pursuant to Rule 914 of Chapter 3: Water Pollution, shall modify the NPDES Permit IL 0001619 consistent with the conditions set forth in this Order.
4. Within forty-five days of the date of this Order, Petitioner shall execute and forward to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, Variance Section, 2200 Churchill Road, Springfield, Illinois 62706, a Certificate of Acceptance and Agreement to be bound to all terms and conditions of this variance. This forty-five day period shall be held in abeyance for any period this matter is being appealed. The form of the Certificate shall be as follows:
