HEARING OFFICER ORDER


On February 9, 2017, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer. Discussions centered on potential hearing dates. Complainants, due to various scheduling conflicts, could not be available for hearing until the last week of June 2017. To that end, all parties agreed that a hearing could be held on July 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21, 2017. It was also agreed that the hearing will be held at the James R. Thompson Center, 100 West Randolph, Chicago, Illinois. I will schedule a hearing room and notice it accordingly.

The parties were directed to submit a proposed schedule for filing witness lists, exhibit lists, supplemental discovery, motions' *in limine* and prehearing memorandums on or before April 3, 2017.

I also informed the parties that I will reserve ruling on complainants' motion *in limine* to exclude the testimony of Mr. David Callen and their pending motion to reply until when and if a hearing on remedy is held.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on April 6, 2017, at 10:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainants, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


