JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012).

FACTS

- Timothy Lewis and William Lewis are the current owners ("Respondents") of a facility located at 240 Main Street, Burnt Prairie, White County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Lewis Scrap Metal Maintenance Shop.
 - 2. That said facility is designated with Site Code No. 1930050003.
 - 3. That Respondents have owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on February 3, 2014, Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 5. That on 3-7-14, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7012 0470 0001 3000 7701

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of the February 3, 2014 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondents caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2012).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2012), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>April 18, 2014</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2012), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2012), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative

Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2012). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.



General Remarks: A Used / Waste Tire Storage Inspection was conducted on Monday, February 3, 2014, at Lewis Scrap Metal Maintenance Shop. The Inspection was conducted by Garrison Gross representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land. The site is located at ~240 Main Street, Burnt Prairie, Illinois 62820. The inspection was performed due to the offsite observation of used / waste tires. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were clear skies, 32° F, with a moderate breeze. Surface conditions at the site were frozen to muddy.

<u>Inspection Findings</u>: The inspection began at approximately 3:20 P.M. I had previously discussed the site with William "Billy" Lewis while conducting an inspection at the Lewis Scrap Metal, LLC salvage yard. I entered the property and continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site. Mr. Lewis told me that reusable used tires were collected at the salvage yard and hauled to the maintenance shop. The facility reuses some of the tires on their fleet of trucks and they intend to sell some of the tires to a retredder.

Tire Storage: The tires were being stored in and around five (5) box trailers (photo 001). Approximately 360 tires were stored at the site (photos 002-006, 008, 011). Approximately 35 tires were being stored outside on the ground and not protected from accumulating water. Several tires had accumulated water and ice (photos 007, 009 and 010). The facility is not registered as a tire storage site. Three of the box trailers were missing one or both of the rear doors. One had a roll up door but it was unknown if it functioned. The sea-land trailer appeared to be equipped with working doors. The damaged / missing doors should be repaired or replaced or a new securable entryway should be constructed to prevent unauthorized access to the trailers. The inspection ended at approximately 3:30 P.M.

<u>Additional Remarks</u>: A Used Tire Activity Registration / Notification Form has not been submitted for the maintenance shop. Information obtained from the White County Supervisor of Assessment's Office indicated that tax bills are mailed to Timothy Lewis and William Lewis, 593 CR 2575 North, Burnt Prairie, Illinois 62820 for parcels # 02-19-155-009 and 02-19-155-10.




