Incorporation of the transcript will also make it necessary for the Agency to call Petitioner's witness from the Permit Appeal, Ken Willings, for further cross-examination of the current accuracy and relevance of his twelve-year old testimony if it is to also be used as evidence in the Adjusted Standard proceeding.

- 6. The Board's procedural rules clearly indicate that proceedings must not be consolidated where the burdens of proof vary. See, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.406. Allowing the incorporation of the prior hearing testimony begins to approach a consolidation of proceedings that would otherwise be prohibited by the Board's rules.
- 7. At this late date, the Agency can only conclude that its case is will prejudiced by Petitioner's request and respectfully requests that the Hearing Officer deny the instant Motion to Incorporate the Transcript of PCB 91-17 into the Record of AS 02-05.
