**MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE AGENCY'S
RECOMMENDATION**

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA" or "Agency"), by and through its attorney, hereby submits its Motion for an Extension of Time to file the Agency's Recommendation with respect to the Variance Petition filed by the Petitioner. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA states as follows:

1. On July 21, 2015, the Petitioner filed its Variance Petition from the chloride water quality standards recently adopted in R08-09.
2. Pursuant to the hearing officer Order issued on August 6, 2015, the Agency is to file its recommendation with respect to the variance petition on September 4, 2015.
3. Illinois EPA is currently reviewing the variance petition and also plans to have conversations with USEPA and the Petitioner before preparing its recommendation. Due to schedules and conversations needed with USEPA and the Petitioner, additional time is needed to finalize the Agency's recommendation.

4. The Agency has reached out to the Petitioner and they have advised Illinois EPA that they have no objection to the requested extension of time to file the Agency's recommendation.

5. The requested extension should not prejudice or harm any interested party.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests the Illinois Pollution Control Board grant it's Motion for an Extension of Time for the Agency's recommendation and grant the Agency an additional 90 days from the September 4, 2015 deadline to file its recommendation with the Board. Therefore, the Agency's recommendation would be due on December 3, 2015.
