JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2002).

FACTS

- 1. That Robert J. and Rita M. Adams ("Respondents") are the present owners of a property located at 1776 County Road 850 E, Metamora, Woodford County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Adams Property.
- 2. That Arlyn Ray d/b/a Arlyn Ray Construction and Tom Romero d/b/a Arlyn Ray Exteriors, ("Respondents") were using the Adams property as a construction and demolition debris dumpsite.
- 3. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 2038005004.
- 4. That Respondents, Robert J. Adams and Rita M. Adams, have owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.

5. That on February 26, 2004, Robert J. Wagner of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Robert J. Wagner during the course of his February 26, 2004 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2002).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2002).
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the deposition of waste in standing or flowing waters, a violation of Section 21(p)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(4) (2002).
- (4) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2002).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2002), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Six Thousand Dollars</u> (\$6,000.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>May 17, 2004</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2002), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2002), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2002). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

Narrative

On February 26, 2004, a re-inspection took place at property owned by Robert and Rita Adams. The property is located at 1776 County Road 850 E, Metamora, Illinois. Dawn Ingold and Robert Wagner (author of this report), of DLPC/FOS conducted the inspection. There was a man on site but he did not give his name to this author. He did acknowledge this author.

History

The purpose of the re-inspection was to check the compliance status of the Adams Property. On October 28, 2003, an open dump inspection took place at the property. The property was being used as a construction and demolition debris dumpsite for Arlyn Ray Construction and Arlyn Ray Exteriors. Arlyn Ray Construction is owned and operated by Arlyn Ray. Arlyn Ray Exteriors is owned and operated by Tom Romero. The following violations were observed during the inspection: Section 21(a), Section 21(d)(1), Section 21(d)(2), Section 21(e), Section 21(p)(1), Section 21(p)(7) and Section 55(a)(1) of the Act and Section 812.101 of the Regulations.

On November 12, 2003, Mr. and Mrs. Adams, Mr. Ray and Mr. Romero were sent Administrative Citation Warning Notices (ACWNs). Mr. and Mrs. Adams, and Mr. Romero did not respond to the ACWNs.

Inspection

This author observed two additional open dumpsites located on the property. In this report, the dumpsites will be referred to as Area 1, Area 2, and Area 3 (see aerial photograph).

Area 1

Area 1 was the dumpsite that was originally inspected during the October 28, 2003 inspection of the property. This author observed dry wall, shingles, couches, tires, white goods, fencing, empty drums, windows, plastic containers, cardboard, paper, bicycle parts, siding, metal debris, electrical conduit, processed wood, metal containers, and bed springs dumped into a ravine. Photographs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 show the ravine (see site sketch A). Mr. Adams uses the tractor shown in photograph 25 to push the waste material into the ravine.

This author observed the charred remains of debris in two burn piles located on Area 1. Photograph 3 shows the charred remains of processed wood, metal debris, and paper (see site sketch A). Photographs 9 and 10 show the charred remains of processed wood and metal debris (see site sketch A). Although Mr. Adams was not present during this inspection, he estimated during the previous inspection that the current dump is approximately 30 feet deep. This author with the help of Mr. Adams estimates the size of Area 1 to be approximately 100 feet long by 75 feet wide by 30 foot deep in size (8300 yd³).

Area 2

Area 2 was observed while trying to contact Mr. Adams at his home on the property. The dumpsite was not assessable from where this author was located. It was located on the other side of a livestock area. This author took photographs of Area 2 from a distance. Photographs 26 and 27 show Area 2 (see site sketch B). Area 2 appeared to consist of demolition debris. The size of Area 2 is undetermined because this author could not physically walk the area.

Area 3

Area 3 is located along a creek at the entrance to the Adams Property. This author observed shingles, reclining chairs, a toilet, glass, fencing, plastic containers, cardboard, paper, metal debris, electrical appliances, and processed wood dumped into and along a creek that is located on the Adams Property. Photographs 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, and 45 show Area 3 (see site sketch C). This author estimates the size of Area 3 to be approximately 35 feet long by 4 feet wide by 5 foot deep in size (700 yd³).

The Agency received a written response to the ACWN dated November 12, 2003 from Arlyn Ray, owner of Arlyn Ray Construction. Mr. Ray admitted that he has dumped debris at the Adams Property. He has contacted Mr. Adams about cleaning up the site. According to Mr. Ray, Mr. and Mrs. Adams are refusing to let him clean up the property. This author spoke to Mr. Ray by telephone. Mr. Ray admitted to this author that he did pay a "tipping fee" to Mr. Adams in order to dump at the property. Mr. Ray told this author the payment was a donation to Mr. Adams.

This author spoke to Bob Millie a representative of Arlyn Ray Exteriors. Mr. Millie works directly for Mr. Romero. According Mr. Millie, his crews did dump debris at the Adams Property. Mr. Millie said that Arlyn Ray Exteriors thought this was a legal activity because they paid Mr. Adams a tipping fee. Arlyn Ray Exteriors is no longer in business. The address on the open dump checklist was given to this author by the Washington Police Department.

The Agency has not received a written response to the ACWN dated November 12, 2003 from Mr. Romero or Mr. and Mrs. Adams. This author departed the site at 11:40 AM.

The following alleged violations were observed and indicated on the open dump inspection checklist:

1. Pursuant to Section 9(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/9(a)), no person shall cause or threaten or allow the discharge or emission of any contaminant into the environment in any State so as to cause or tend to cause air pollution in Illinois, either alone or in combination with contaminants from other sources, or so as to violate regulations or standards adopted by the Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 9(a) is alleged for the following reason: Evidence of open burning which would cause or tend to cause air pollution in Illinois was observed during the inspection.

2. Pursuant to Section 9(c) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/9(c)), no person shall cause or allow the open burning of refuse, conduct any salvage operation by open burning, or cause or allow the burning of any refuse in any chamber not specifically designed for the purpose and approved by the Agency pursuant to regulations adopted by the Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 9(c) is alleged for the following reason: Evidence of open burning was observed during the inspection.

3. Pursuant to Section 12(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/12(a)), no person shall cause or threaten or allow the discharge of any contaminants into the environment in any State so as to cause or tend to cause water pollution in Illinois, either alone or in combination with the matter from other sources, or so as to violate regulations or standards adopted by the Pollution Control Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 12(a) is alleged for the following reason: The discharge of contaminants was caused, threatened, or allowed, so as to cause or tend to cause water pollution in Illinois.

4. Pursuant to Section 12(d) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/12(d)), no person shall deposit any contaminants upon the land in such place and manner so as to create a water pollution hazard.

A violation of Section 12(d) is alleged for the following reason: Contaminants were deposited upon the land in such place and manner so as to create a water pollution hazard.

5. Pursuant to Section 21(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(a)), no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste.

A violation of Section 21(a) is alleged for the following reason: Evidence of open dumping of waste was observed during the inspection.

6. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit granted by the Agency or in violation of any conditions imposed by such permit.

A violation of Section 21(d)(1) is alleged for the following reason: Waste was disposed without a permit granted by the Illinois EPA.

7. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(2)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 21(d)(2) is alleged for the following reason: A waste disposal operation was conducted in violation of regulations adopted by the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

8. Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)), no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(e) is alleged for the following reason: Waste was disposed at this site which does not meet the requirements of the Act and regulations thereunder.

9. Pursuant to Section 21(p)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1)), no person shall, in violation of subdivision (a) of this Section, cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in litter.

The prohibitions specified in this subsection (p) shall be enforceable by the Agency either by administrative citation under Section 31.1 of this Act or as otherwise provided by this Act. The specific prohibitions in this subsection do not limit the power of the Board to establish regulations or standards applicable to open dumping.

A violation of Section 21(p)(1) is alleged for the following reason: The open dumping of waste was caused or allowed in a manner which resulted in litter.

10. Pursuant to Section 21(p)(3) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3)), no person shall, in violation of subdivision (a) of this Section, cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in open burning.

A violation of Section 21(p)(3) is alleged for the following reason: The open dumping of waste was caused or allowed in a manner which resulted in open burning.

11. Pursuant to Section 21(p)(4) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(4)), no person shall, in violation of subdivision (a) of this Section, cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in the deposition of waste in standing or flowing waters.

A violation of Section 21(p)(4) is alleged for the following reason: The open dumping of waste was caused or allowed in a manner which resulted in the deposition of waste in standing or flowing waters.

12. Pursuant to Section 21(p)(7) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7)), no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of waste in a manner that results in deposition of general or clean construction or demolition debris.

A violation of Section 21(p)(7) is alleged for the following reason: The open dumping of waste was caused or allowed in a manner which resulted in deposition of general or clean construction or demolition debris.

13. Pursuant to Section 55(a)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(a)(1)), no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any used or waste tire.

A violation of Section 55(a)(1) is alleged for the following reason: Evidence of open dumping of used or waste tires was observed during the inspection.

14. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 812.101(a), all persons, except those specifically exempted by Section 21(d) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act, shall submit to the Agency an application for a permit to develop and operate a landfill.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 812.101(a) is alleged for the following reason: A waste disposal site was operated without submitting to the Illinois EPA an application for a permit to develop and operate a landfill.
