## HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On February 17, 18 and 19, 2004, a hearing in this matter was held at the Marshall County Courthouse, 122 North Prairie Street, Lacon, Illinois. Attorneys Richard Kissel, Mark Latham and Sheila Deely appeared and participated in behalf of the petitioner. Attorney Deborah Williams appeared and participated on hehalf of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency).

#### **Preliminary Matters**

Petitioner made an oral motion on February 19, 2004, that the entire transcript of the hearing in permit appeal PCB 91-17, including the transcript of the hearing held on February 17, 2004, be incorporated into this adjusted standard matter. On February 10, 2004, the hearing officer denied petitioner's motion to incorporate the November 19, 1991 transcript of the hearing in PCB 91-17 in a written order. To that end, the record reflects that the entire transcript of the PCB 91-17 proceedings, including the transcript of the hearing held on February 17, 2004, is taken with the case as an offer of proof.

## Witness Credibility

Both parties presented witnesses. Based on my observations, experience and legal knowledge, witness credibility is not an issue.

#### **Exhibits**

Both parties offered exhibits as evidence at the hearing. An exhibit list itemizing the offered exhibits and summarizing their status is attached to this order.

## **Briefing Schedule**

At the hearing, a post-hearing briefing schedule was discussed and agreed to. The petitioner's post-hearing brief is due to be filed on or before April 29, 2004. The Agency's post-hearing brief is due to be filed on or before June 15, 2004. The petitioner's reply, if any, is due to be filed on or before July 14, 2004. Public comment is due to be filed on or before March 22, 2004.
