
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On August 18, 2021, respondent filed a motion for extension of time to file its opening post-hearing brief. (Mot.). Respondent's original due date is September 7, 2021. Respondent requests an additional 30-days, or October 7, 2021, to file its brief. Respondent reports that "due to work schedules, workload, issues regarding the Illinois Attorney General's Office's network and leaves from office, it will not be able to file its opening brief by September 7, 2021." Mot. at 1-2. Respondent states that complainant will agree to an additional 14 days. *Id.*

On August 23, 2021, complainant filed its response. (Resp). In summary, complainant argues that an additional 14 days is sufficient to complete the brief and none of the reasons respondent puts forth in its motion are sufficient for an additional 30 days. Resp. at 1-2.

I find that the reasons put forth by the respondent for additional time sufficient, especially the Attorney General's network computer issues. Therefore, I grant respondent's motion to the extent that they are given an additional 21 days, or September 28, 2021, to file its opening brief. Complainant's reply brief is now due by October 28, 2021.


