I, Michelle M. Ryan, being first duly sworn upon oath, depose and state as follows:

1. I am employed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), as Assistant Counsel for the Bureau of Land.

2. As part of my duties, I am responsible for the preparation of Administrative Citations issued by the Illinois EPA and the negotiation and litigation of appeals filed pursuant to such Administrative Citations. As part of my job experience, I have also submitted travel vouchers for reimbursement.


3. I have reviewed the Illinois EPA Division of Legal Counsel File 565-02-AC, which relates to AC 03-13, *Illinois EPA v. Dan Cadwallader*, for the purpose of determining the costs expended by Illinois EPA.

4. I was the Illinois EPA attorney assigned to handle the hearing for AC 03-13, which was held in Hennepin. I was required to travel from Springfield to Hennepin and back for the hearing. The Illinois Department of Transportation map of the State of Illinois indicates that the distance between Springfield and Hennepin is 132 miles. Based on my own job experience, I am aware that the approved mileage reimbursement rate in December 2003 was \$.36 per mile.



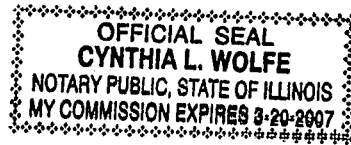
costs expended by Illinois EPA on this Administrative Citation through the hearing date approximate


