**REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE RECORD**

NOW COMES Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, by and through the Attorney General of the State of Illinois, *ex rel.* LISA MADIGAN and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116, hereby requests a two week extension of time in which to file the record for this permit appeal. In support of this request, Respondent states as follows:

1. By Order of the Board of December 5, 2013, the Respondent was ordered to file the entire record of its determination by Monday, December 23, 2013, unless the Board or the hearing officers orders otherwise.

2. The Record cannot be completed for filing by December 23, 2013, for several reasons including the following:

a. The permit writer is now on vacation and the Respondent cannot verify that it has all necessary documents for the record from the permit writer before December 23, 2013.

b. The Assistant Attorney General assigned to this matter was only given this matter late December 19, 2013, and more time is needed to verify the accuracy of the record, the index, the numbering and the proper preparation of the record for filing with the Illinois

Pollution Control Board.


3. Due to vacations and schedules over the holidays, a two week extension is needed to allow the Respondent adequate time and resources to gather all materials for the record and to comply with content requirements.

4. The Petitioner has no objection to an extension of time for the Respondent to file the Record.
