REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to August 10, 2004, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from April 7, 2004, the date of service of the Illinois EPA's final decision. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On April 6, 2004, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner. (Exhibit A)
- 2. On May 3, 2004, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition to ninety days. The Petitioner represented that the final decision was received on April 7, 2004. (Exhibit B)
- 3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the Site Classification Work Plan (plan) submitted for the above-referenced incident. This plan, dated December 23, 2003, was received by the Illinois EPA on December 26, 2003. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

The Illinois EPA requires modification of the plan; therefore, the plan is conditionally approved with the Illinois EPA's modifications. The Illinois EPA has determined that the modifications below are necessary to demonstrate compliance with Title XVI of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732 (Section 57.7(a)(1) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.305(c) or 732.312(j)):

- 1. The Agency is not approving the proposed round 2 site investigation at this time. The budget proposed in the plan also reflects this request.
- 2. Based on information in the site file there was never a diesel tank on-site nor did the waste oil tank have a release, based on this the indicator contaminants for the site are BTEX only. The proposed budget also reflects this determination.
- 3. The site file fails to indicate whether the underground storage tanks have been excavated or remain on-site.
- 4. The Agency is requesting that round 1 proposed soil boring/well BH-12/MW-9 be relocated south of previous soil boring B-5 along the west property line. The Agency is requesting that proposed soil boring BH-2/MW-1 be relocated north of previous soil boring B-3 across Oak Street, and proposed soil boring BH-3/MW-2 be relocated south of previous soil boring B-6 south of the buildings.



Based on the modifications listed in Section 2 of Attachment A, the amounts listed in Section 1 of Attachment A are approved. Please note that the costs must be incurred in accordance with the approved plan. Be aware that the amount of reimbursement may be limited by Sections 57.8(e), 57.8(g), and 57.8(d) of the Act, as well as 35 III. Adm. Code 732.604, 732.606(s), and 732.611.

Please note that, if the owner or operator agrees with the Illinois EPA's modifications, submittal of an amended plan is not required (Section 57.7(c)(4) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.503(f)).

NOTE: Amended plans and/or budgets must be submitted and approved prior to the issuance of a No Further Remediation (NFR) Letter. Costs associated with a plan or budget that have not been approved prior to the issuance of an NFR Letter will not be reimbursable.

As a result of the Illinois EPA's modification(s) in Section 2 of this Attachment A, the following amounts are approved:

SECTION 2

1. \$48,198.45 for an adjustment in plan modification and unreasonable costs. The Illinois EPA has determined that these costs are not reasonable as submitted (Section 57.7(c)(4)(C) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.606(hh)). One of the overall goals of the financial review is to assure that costs associated with materials, activities, and services are reasonable (35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.505(c)). Please note that additional information and/or supporting documentation may be provided to demonstrate the costs are reasonable.

The following proposed costs were deducted from the budget based on the denial of the round II investigation and PNA and metals analysis:

Investigation -- \$8,818.75 Analysis -- \$28,952.00 Equipment -- \$560.00 Field Purchases -- \$60.00

The amount proposed for the round I drilling costs was deemed unreasonable with \$1,680.00 deducted from the investigative portion of the budget. The amount proposed for well materials was deemed unreasonable with \$1,488.50 deducted from the budget.

The amount requested for latex gloves was deemed unreasonable with \$67.20 deducted from the budget. The amount proposed for the PID meter was deemed unreasonable with \$15.00 deducted from the budget. The amount proposed for the transducer/data logger was deemed unreasonable with \$102.00 deducted from the budget. The amount proposed for survey equipment was deemed unreasonable with \$41.00 deducted from the budget. The amount proposed for the lazer level was deemed unreasonable with \$60.00 deducted from the budget. The amount proposed for the ISWS & ISGS was deemed unreasonable with \$30.00 deducted from the budget. The amount proposed for personnel costs were deemed unreasonable with \$6,324.00 deducted from the personnel portion of the budget.

2. \$2,572.40 for an adjustment in handling charges. Handling charges are eligible for payment only if they are equal to or less than the amount determined by the following table (Section 57.8(g) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.607):

Appeal Rights

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Sections 40 and 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sent to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.
