HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On June 15, 2016, all parties participated in a telephonic status conference with the

hearing officer. The parties stated that the related circuit court matter continues with argument scheduled in August regarding a motion for partial summary judgment. BNSF Railway Company (BNSF) stated that pursuant to a Consent Order it submitted a Remedial Objective Plan and a Remedial Action Plan with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The Agency denied the remedial plans based on various issues on a portion of the contaminated site. BNSF was given until November 2016 to file a written response to the Agency. Depending on the outcome of the circuit court proceedings, Indian Creek Development Company may amend its complaint before the Board.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to appear at a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on August 31, 2016, at 11:30 a.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the complainant, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.
