ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Motion filed September 12, 1973 by Ashland Chemical Company to extend the time by which any odor nuisance shall be abated to and including November 15, 1973 is granted.

Paragraph 1 of the Board's order of April 12, 1973 now reads.

"1. Respondents, Lonza and Ashland, shall each submit to the Environmental Protection Agency, within 60 days from the date hereof, a program for abatement of their odor nuisances as found in this opinion and shall achieve abatement of such odor nuisances as follows: for Lonza, Inc. within 150 days from the date hereof; for Ashland Chemical Company by and including November 15, 1973."
