MOTION TO VOLUNTARILY DISMISS

NOW COMES Petitioners, Ameren Energy Generating Company and Venice Power Plant, by and through their attorneys, Schiff Hardin LLP, and pursuant to Section 101.500 of the Illinois Pollution Control Board's (Board's) procedural rules and moves the Board to dismiss this Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit appeal and close the docket, stating as follows:

1. On April 23, 2009, Petitioner filed a Petition for Review of CAAPP Permit No. 95090017 issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency to Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE (now Ameren Energy Generating Company) and a request for a stay of the contested conditions.
2. On July 23, 2009, the Board stayed the effectiveness of the contested conditions pending the final resolution of the appeal.
3. The parties came to an agreement about the issues raised in the appeal.
4. Petitioners received a final modified CAAP permit addressing the issues raised in the appeal on December 28, 2016.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners move the Board to grant the Motion to Voluntarily Dismiss, dismiss this appeal, and close the docket.
