ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Glosser):

On April 23, 2009, Ameren Energy Generating Company (Ameren Energy) and Gibson City Power Plant filed a petition asking the Board to review a March 19, 2009 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2008), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.302. The Agency issued a renewed Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) permit, subject to conditions, for the Gibson City Power Plant facility, an electric generating station owned and operated by Ameren Energy, located at 545 North Jordan Drive in Gibson City, Ford County.

On January 13, 2014, Ameren Energy and Gibson City Power Plant filed a motion to dismiss (Mot.) this permit appeal. Ameren Energy and Gibson City Power Plant stated in its motion that the Agency has issued a revised CAAPP permit and, as a result, Ameren Energy and Gibson City Power Plant “no longer seek to appeal the [Agency’s] CAAPP permit decision at issue in this proceeding.” Mot. at 1. The Board grants Ameren Energy and Gibson City Power Plant’s motion, dismisses this case, and closes the docket.
