
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.M. Keenan):

On November 3, 2005, Ameren Energy Generating Company petitioned the Board for review of a Clean Air Act Permit Program permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency for Ameren’s coal-fired power plant at 800 South Washington Street, Meredosia, Morgan County. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40.2(a) (2014); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.300, *et seq.* Ameren challenged certain permit conditions and asked the Board to remand it to the Agency.

On December 30, 2015, Ameren moved to dismiss its appeal. Ameren also stated that the Agency had no objection to the motion. This order grants Ameren’s motion, dismisses the case, and closes the docket.
