MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENT TO ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD

NOW COMES the Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY ("Illinois EPA"), by and through its attorneys, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.500 and moves the ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD ("Board") for leave to file the attached Supplement to Administrative Record.

- 1. Petitioners filed their Petition with the Board on November 3, 2005, seeking a review of certain permit conditions contained within the Clean Air Act Permit Program ("CAAPP") permit issued to Ameren Energy Resources Generating Company ("Ameren" or "Newton") by the Illinois EPA on September 29, 2005. The permit authorized the operation of an electrical power generation facility known as the Newton Power Station. The facility is located at 6725 North 500th Street in Newton, Illinois. Formal notice of the appeal was served upon the Illinois EPA on November 4, 2005.
- On November 17, 2005, the Board accepted Ameren's Petition for hearing and, consistent with the Board's procedural rules, directed the Illinois EPA to file its
 Administrative Record. Consistent with the Hearing Officer's Order of April 6, 2006, the

Illinois EPA filed its Administrative Record underlying its CAAPP permitting decision for the Newton Power Plant on April 13, 2006. The Administrative Record totaled in excess of 14, 200 pages. Of this total, approximately 4,600 pages were particular to the Newton plant, alone, and approximately 9,600 pages were characterized as "General Reference Material" and were generally applicable to twenty-two Title V appeals filed by Illinois sources that comprise the coal-fired power plant industry in Illinois.

- 3. In July 2007, the Illinois EPA discovered that one document had been mistakenly overlooked in its filing of the April 13, 2006, Administrative Record for the Newton Power Plant, a letter from J.T. Birkett, Vice President, Central Illinois Public Service Company, to Donald Sutton, Manager, Permit Section, Division of Air Pollution Control, dated September 6, 1995, and accompanying operating permit application for the Newton Power Station.
- 4. On August 10, 2007, the undersigned counsel left a message for Petitioner's counsel inquiring whether Petitioner had an objection to this Motion for Leave to Supplement Administrative Record. At the time of mailing this Motion for Leave to Supplement Administrative Record, counsel has not yet heard whether Petitioner has an objection to said motion.
 - 5. Petitioner will suffer no hardship by the granting of this Motion.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA respectfully requests that the Board grant this

Motion for Leave to Supplement Administrative Record.

The Respondent, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by and through its attorneys and pursuant to the procedural requirements of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") set forth at 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.302(f), files this Supplement to Administrative Record ("Supplement to Administrative Record") in this cause.

Acting in accordance with its authority under the CAAPP provisions of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter "Act"), 415 ILCS 5/39.5(2004), the Illinois EPA issued a CAAPP permit to Ameren Energy Resources Generating Company ("Ameren") on September 29, 2005. The permit authorized the operation of an electrical power generation facility known as the Newton Power Station. The facility is located at 6725 North 500th Street in Newton, Illinois. On November 3, 2005, Petitioner filed a petition before the Board challenging certain permit conditions contained within the Clean Air Act Permit Program ("CAAPP") permit issued by the Illinois EPA.

On November 17, 2005, the Board accepted Ameren's Petition for hearing and, consistent with the Board's procedural rules, directed the Illinois EPA to file its Administrative Record. Consistent with the Hearing Officer's Order of April 6, 2006, the Illinois EPA filed its Administrative Record underlying its CAAPP permitting decision for the Newton Power Plant on April 13, 2006. The Administrative Record totaled in excess of 14, 200 pages. Of this total, approximately 4,600 pages were particular to the Newton plant, alone, and approximately 9,600 pages were characterized as "General Reference Material" and were generally applicable to twenty-two Title V appeals filed by Illinois sources that comprise the coal-fired power plant industry in Illinois.

This Supplement to the Administrative Record is particular to the Newton Power Plant, alone, and consists of a letter from J.T. Birkett, Vice President, Central Illinois Public Service Company, to Donald Sutton, Manager, Permit Section, Division of Air Pollution Control, dated September 6, 1995, and accompanying operating permit application. This Supplement to the Administrative Record continues with the sequential numbering of the Administrative Record filed on April 13, 2006; it begins where the numbering in the April Administrative Record ended at page number 4623.
