**ILLINOIS POLLUTION CONTROL BOARD
NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND
PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF
ENFORCEMENT CASE**

The Attorney General has brought a case against Professional Swine Management, LLC (PSM), Hilltop View LLC, Wildcat Farms, LLC, High-Power Pork, LLC, Eagle Point, LLC, Lone Hollow, LLC, Timberline, LLC, Prairie State Gilts, Ltd., North Fork Pork, LLC, Little Timber, LLC, and Twin Valley Pumping, Inc. for violation of State pollution control rules at nine livestock facilities managed by PSM. These facilities are located in the following counties;

Schuyler, Hancock, Adams, and Fulton. On September 22, 2016, the parties filed a stipulation and proposal for settlement. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing. Any person desiring that a hearing be held may demand a public hearing in this case by filing a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice. The hearing request should refer People of the State of Illinois v. Professional Swine Management, LLC, Hilltop View LLC, Wildcat Farms, LLC, High-Power Pork, LLC, Eagle Point, LLC, Lone Hollow, LLC, Timberline, LLC, Prairie State Gilts, Ltd., North Fork Pork, LLC, Little Timber, LLC, and Twin Valley Pumping, Inc. PCB 10-84 and should be mailed to the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 West Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601.
