PETITION FOR REVIEW OF ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY DECISION

Keller Oil Company / Sullivan Super K ("Sullivan Super K"), by its attorney, Carolyn S. Hesse of Barnes & Thornburg, pursuant to the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq. (the "Act") and 35 Illinois Administrative Code Section 105.400 et. seq., hereby appeals certain decisions by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (the "Agency").

- 1. Keller Oil Company / Sullivan Super K ("Petitioner"), is the owner of a gasoline service station located 104 South Hamilton, Sullivan, Moultrie County, Illinois (the "Station"). This gasoline service station had underground storage tanks (UST's) on the property, which stored gasoline and diesel fuel.
- LUST Incident Number 992030 was obtained following a site investigation. The site has also been assigned LPC #1390305037-Moultrie County.

- 3. On June 5, 2001, CW³M, the contractor hired by Sullivan Super K to assist Sullivan Super K with corrective action at the Station, sent to the Agency a Site Investigation Report and Corrective Action Plan and Budget to perform corrective action at the Station. (See Exhibit 1.)
- 4. On September 24, 2001, the Agency sent a letter to Petitioner rejecting the June 5, 2001, High Priority Corrective Action Plan and Budget. The letter included a list of additional information requested by the Agency and acknowledged that the corrective action included bioremediation. (See Exhibit 2.) CW³M provided the additional information requested by the Agency on September 24, 2001 and on subsequent dates.
- 5. By letter dated June 7, 2002, the Agency approved the Amended High Priority Corrective Action Plan dated March 5, 2002, but cut part of the budget for this plan. (See Exhibit 3.) On behalf of Petitioner, CW³M submitted on July 5, 2002, additional information related to the budget, including costs for the pilot study required for bioremediation projects. (See Exhibit 4.)
- 6. On October 28, 2002, the Agency again requested a modification of the proposed budget (See Exhibit 5), and CW³M provided the requested information on November 22, 2002. (See Exhibit 6.)
- 7. On February 24, 2003, the Agency approved the proposed budget subject to the Agency's modifications to the proposed budget. (See Exhibit 7.)
- 8. By cover letter dated May 19, 2003, CW³M forwarded on behalf of Petitioner a Phase II Corrective Action Plan (CAP) and Budget which

- included the results of the *in-situ* bioremediation treatability study and proposed full-scale implementation of *in-situ* bioremediation.
- 9. On August 8, 2003 the Agency sent to Petitioner a letter rejecting the High Priority Corrective Action Plan. The letter listed five questions/comments, including questions about the "exact specifications of the bioslurry material," including "manufacturer's specifications and amount of oxygen released per pound of material." The Agency also required that site names and IEPA generator numbers be provided for sites for which the proposed remediation technology had been approved. (See Exhibit 8.)
- 10. In response, by letter dated October 31, 2003, CW³M, on behalf of Petitioner, provided to the Agency information relating to the bioslurry material. CW³M also responded to the Agency's comments and provided a list of 161 site names and generator numbers where the Agency approved bioremediation. This list was obtained from the Agency's database. (See Exhibit 9.)
- 11. On December 26, 2003, CW³M received a letter dated December 24, 2003 rejecting the High Priority Correction Action Plan for the reason that "the method of remediation cannot be approved." The Agency also disapproved the budget to perform the work. (See Exhibit 10.)
- 12. The Agency's letter of December 24, 2003, provides no additional information regarding why IEPA disapproved a remediation technology that it had approved previously.

- 13. The Agency's December 24, 2003, letter includes an attachment labeled appeal rights as the Agency's decision is a final decision, appealable to the Illinois Pollution Control Board.
- 14. The Agency has violated 35 Ill. Admin. Code 732.503(b) because the Agency's December 24, 2003, letter did not provide Petitioner written notice with the following information:
 - (1) An explanation of the specific type of information, if any, that the Agency needs to complete the full review;
 - (2) An explanation of the Sections of the Act or regulations that may be violated if the plan or report is approved; and
 - (3) A statement of specific reasons why the cited Sections of the Act or regulations may be violated if the plan or report is approved.

WHEREFORE, Keller Oil / Sullivan Super K respectfully requests that the Board enter an order requiring the Agency to approve the Corrective Action Plan and Budget to allow the cleanup to proceed at this facility and for Keller Oil / Sullivan Super K's attorneys' fees and costs in bringing this appeal.



 - D) PH of groundwater within the contaminated aquifer.
 - E) Groundwater temperature within the contaminated aquifer.
 - F) Background aerobic and heterotrophic bacteria counts within the contaminated aquifer.
 - G) Groundwater mineral content within the contaminated aquifer.
 - H) Available concentrations of ammonia and nitrogen in the aquifer within the contaminated aquifer.
 - I) Argument supporting the biodegradability of the indicator contaminants within the contaminated aquifer.
 - J) Calculations and testing which prove the amount of groundwater affected by the contamination.
 - K) Design area of influence which is an estimate of the volume/area of aquifer to which an adequate amount of electron acceptor and nutrient can be supplied to sustain microbial activity. Additionally, the design radius of influence must be shown for the site. Together, these determine the practicality of the design.



Dear Mr. Rothering:

Enclosed, please find a Corrective Action Plan Budget Amendment (CAP) for the L. Keller Oil Properties, Inc./Sullivan Super K, located in Sullivan, Illinois.

In response to your June 7, 2002 letter modifying the CAP budget, we have included a breakdown of the \$21,719.50 cut from personnel. The specific hours and tasks for investigation and reimbursement preparation are included in the "Investigation" and "Reporting" spreadsheets which follow the IEPA forms in the budget section. The investigation hours include field preparation, drilling plans, utility locations, mapping, drilling, sampling, surveying and obtaining off-site access. The other item included in the budget is the estimated cost of the microbial degredation pilot study. Although the letter requests certified costs from a laboratory, this is not practical, since the costs incurred depend upon the results of the testing. If additional testing is needed, the laboratory costs increase. The \$3,500 budgeted is a reasonable estimate of what the testing could be. We have included, as Attachment B, a copy of the most recent price schedule from Microbe Inotech Laboratories which includes the rate of \$1,620.00 for an aerobic bioremediation pilot study with nutrient chemistries. At this time, that is also what is included as a budget number. However, if the indigenous bacteria are found to be inadequate, or the chemistry is found to be out of range, a budget amendment will be necessary to retest the samples using foreign bacteria or to adjust the nutrient levels.

The unit rates for the Environmental Engineer and the Engineering Technician have been changed to reflect the rates used in the June 7, 2002 letter. Depending upon the



results of the treatability study, a CAP will be prepared to implement bioremediation, or proposing soil excavation and groundwater treatment.





In response to your August 8, 2003 letter rejecting the Phase II Corrective Action Plan (CAP) and Budget submitted May 19, 2003, CW³M is providing the following information and requesting a reconsideration of the rejection. Responses to the individual items listed in the letter are addressed below.

Item 1. Exact specifications for the bioslurry materials needed are not known, as each injection batch will be unique. The materials that will be or may be used are listed in Section 6.1.3 of the CAP. CW³M will design, then either purchase or prepare each batch individually, depending upon the site conditions determined from the previous analytical data and past experience with the site.

As we have attempted to explain in our previous submittals, the proposed technology does not rely on oxygen, which is extremely difficult to produce and control throughout the vadose and saturated zones. The proposed technology uses the same principle as oxygen injection, but instead relies on controlling the carbon: nitrogen: phosphorous ratio to achieve the same results. Although not considered in the mix formulation as an active ingredient, the dissolved oxygen content in fully-aerated 21° Celsius water is approximately 9.0 mg/L, which is equal to approximately 0.008 pounds of available oxygen per pound of slurry.

Item 3. All of the previously installed monitoring wells have been completed at depths greater than 20 feet. Once fully developed, the greatest depth to groundwater recorded for a monitoring well has been approximately 8 feet. The proposed delivery system was designed with a depth of 10 feet in order to minimize costs and treat both the vadose and saturated zones. During the installation, if the proposed 10 foot depth does not appear to be at or very near the water table, the trench depth will be increased to assure that the injection system can treat both the vadose and saturated zones.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the High Priority Corrective Action Plan (plan) submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information, dated October 31, 2003, was received by the Illinois EPA on November 4, 2003. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Sections 40 and 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sent to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.
