# REQUEST FOR NINETY DAY EXTENSION OF APPEAL PERIOD

NOW COMES the Respondent, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by one of its attorneys, John J. Kim, Assistant Counsel and Special Assistant Attorney General, and, pursuant to Section 40(a)(1) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208, hereby requests that the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board") grant an extension of the thirty-five (35) day period for petitioning for a hearing to September 7, 2004, or any other date not more than a total of one hundred twenty-five (125) days from the date of service of the Illinois EPA's final decision. The 125<sup>th</sup> day is September 6, 2004, a State holiday, and the next business day is September 7, 2004. In support thereof, the Illinois EPA respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On May 3, 2004, the Illinois EPA issued a final decision to the Petitioner. (Exhibit A)
- 2. On June 7, 2004, the Petitioner made a written request to the Illinois EPA for an extension of time by which to file a petition for review, asking the Illinois EPA join in requesting that the Board extend the thirty-five day period for filing a petition to ninety days. The Petitioner represented that the final decision was received on May 4, 2004. (Exhibit B)

3. The additional time requested by the parties may eliminate the need for a hearing in this matter or, in the alternative, allow the parties to identify issues and limit the scope of any hearing that may be necessary to resolve this matter.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the parties request that the Board, in the interest of administrative and judicial economy, grant this request for a ninety-day extension of the thirty-five day period for petitioning for a hearing.

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA) has reviewed the High Priority Corrective Action Plan (plan) submitted for the above-referenced incident. This information, dated February 9, 2004, was received by the Illinois EPA on February 11, 2004. Citations in this letter are from the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and 35 Illinois Administrative Code (35 Ill. Adm. Code).

Pursuant to Section 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 732.405(c), the High Priority Corrective Action Plan is rejected for the following reason(s):

1. Additional information is still needed with regards to the actual makeup of each bio-shury inoculation mixture and the specific steps and information that are taken into consideration to determine the type of mixture and how much is necessary for each injection well. This information must also include a detailed breakdown of the cost of each mixture and/or the individual ingredient costs. Please be advised that the Agency has provisions in place to handle the submission of proprietary information so that trade secrets are not compromised.

Pursuant to Sections 57.7(a)(1) and 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act and 35 III. Adm. Code 732.405(e) and 732.503(b), the associated budget is rejected for the following reason(s):

1. The associated budget is denied due to the fact that the plan for which the budget is associated has been denied. Therefore, the Agency cannot assess the appropriateness of such costs.

### Appeal Rights

An underground storage tank owner or operator may appeal this final decision to the Illinois Pollution Control Board pursuant to Sections 40 and 57.7(c)(4)(D) of the Act by filing a petition for a hearing within 35 days after the date of issuance of the final decision. However, the 35-day period may be extended for a period of time not to exceed 90 days by written notice from the owner or operator and the Illinois EPA within the initial 35-day appeal period. If the owner or operator wishes to receive a 90-day extension, a written request that includes a statement of the date the final decision was received, along with a copy of this decision, must be sent to the Illinois EPA as soon as possible.



### Dear John:

On May 3, 2004, the Agency issued a letter with respect to the above referenced LUST Incident regarding the High Priority Corrective Action Plan submitted to IEPA on February 9, 2004.

The May 3, 2004, letter was received on May 4, 2004 by CW3M on behalf of Telzrow Oil Company. Telzrow Oil Company is located in Calhoun County, Illinois. A copy of the letter is attached. CW3M believes that, based upon discussions with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and for other reasons, that we will be able to resolve the issues raised in the IEPA letter.
