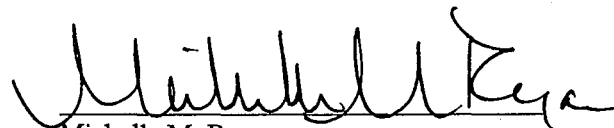

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2002).

FACTS

1. That Respondent, Knox County Landfill Committee, is the permitted owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, a facility located in rural Knox County, near Wataga, Illinois.
2. That Respondent, Greg Ingles, is the Certified Operator of the above-referenced facility.
3. That said facility is operated as a sanitary landfill, operating under Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit No. 1995-337-LF, and is designated with Site Code No. 0958160003. The facility is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Knox County Landfill #3.
5. That Respondents have owned and/or operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.

6. That on December 12, 2003, Jeffrey Port of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-referenced facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Jeffrey Port during the course of his December 12, 2003 inspection of the above-referenced facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents conducted a sanitary landfill in a manner which resulted in uncovered refuse remaining from any previous operating day or at the conclusion of any operating day, unless authorized by permit, a violation of Section 21 (o)(5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21 (o)(5) (2002).
- (2) That Respondents conducted a sanitary landfill operation in a manner which resulted in the failure to collect and contain litter from the site by the end of the operating day, a violation of Section 21(o)(12) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(o)(12) (2002).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4) (2002), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than February 16, 2004, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2002), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2002), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents' check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2002). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

or not required documents were timely filed on behalf of the subject site.

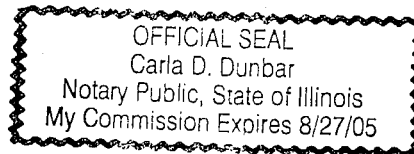

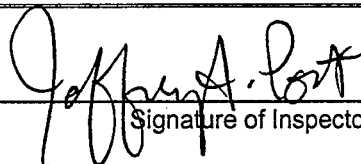

Narrative

IEPA-DLPC

On December 12, 2003, I (Jeff Port) performed a Pre-operation Permit Inspection and a Solid Waste Landfill Inspection at the Knox County Landfill #3 located in rural Knox County, near Wataga. The facility is an 814 Subpart C landfill with authorization under Permit #1994-105-LFM issued on September 29, 1994. The most recent modification, #19 was issued on November 19, 2003. As part of the Pre-operation Permit Inspection for Permit Log No. 2003-412, I needed to examine the liner, leachate drainage and collection systems, and surface water control structures.

I arrived at the site at 5:53 AM. The gate to the facility was locked as seen in photograph P1. Photograph P2 shows the facility's signage. At approximately 7:43 AM, a vehicle approached and opened the exit gate. I waited for the entrance gate to be opened. At approximately 7:52 AM, I proceeded onto the site through the exit gate. I entered the facility's office and asked to speak with the operator. I was introduced to Greg Ingles. I explained to Mr. Ingles that I was the new inspector for the site and I needed to perform a pre-operation permit inspection as well as a solid waste landfill inspection. Mr. Ingles directed me to the facility's active area, but did not accompany me during the inspection. Photographs P3 through P5 show the active area. I observed uncovered refuse from a previous operating day here. Photographs P6 through P11 show additional waste in the general area of the previous day's operating area.

Photographs P12 through P14 taken east of the previous day's operating area, show additional uncovered refuse from a previous operating day. From here I moved eastward. I located a mound of dirt with uncovered refuse exposed. Photographs P15 and P16 show this waste. On the eastern edge of the cells 4 and 5 I observed several area of uncovered refuse. The waste is seen in photographs P17 through P25. Photograph P26 taken on the east edge of cells 4 and 5 show a tree line with waste in the trees. After photographing this area, I proceeded to inspect the newly developed Cell 9.

Photographs P27 through P30 were taken from the southeast corner of Cell 9. The cell's liner was covered with water and ice in this area. The portion of the liner on the southeast corner of the new cell appeared to have fallen and waste from cells 4 and 5 was observed here. Photographs P31 through P35 were taken from the east edge of Cell 9. These photographs show the water and the ice present on the exposed liner. Photographs P36 and P37 taken from the southeast corner of Cell 9 show a portion of the liner that had fallen. Additionally, waste from cells 4 and 5 can be seen here. Photograph P37s through P39 show a pump and hose that appeared to have been used to remove the water from Cell 9. Photographs P41 through P44 were from cells 4 and 5 looking down on Cell 9. They show additional water and ice on the exposed liner. Photographs P45 through P47 were taken from the southwest corner of Cell 9. Another pump was present here. An accumulation of water can be seen in these photographs. It did not appear that Cell 9 had been completed in a manner consistent with the application and that additional work needed to be performed. After photographing this area, I performed a Permitted Compost Facility Inspection at the adjacent compost facility (0950600001). That inspection is under another cover. After the compost facility inspection, I returned to the office where I

discussed the site with Mr. Ingles. I also examined the load checks for the landfill and found these items to be in order. After further discussion with Mr. Ingles, I left the site at 10:10 AM.

Photograph locations are depicted on the accompanying site map. Based upon this inspection, the following violations were found to be continuing.

1. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit granted by the Agency or in violation of any conditions imposed by such permit.

A violation of Section 21(d)(1) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3 failed to comply with the following condition of Permit Number 1994-105-LFM.**

II. Operating Conditions

2. The operator of this solid waste facility shall not conduct the operation in a manner which results in any of the following.

- e. Uncovered refuse remaining from any previous operating day or at the conclusion of any operating day, unless authorized by permit;

Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to provide daily cover to the site.

2. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(2)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 21(d)(2) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, conducted a waste-disposal operation in violation of Section 811.106(a) of the Regulations.**

3. Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)), no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, conducted a waste-disposal operation in violation of**

Sections 21(d)(1), 21(d)(2), 21(e), and 21(o)(5) of the Act and Section 811.106(a) of the Regulations.

4. Pursuant to Section 21(o)(5) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(5)), no person shall conduct a sanitary landfill operation which is required to have a permit under subsection (d) of this Section in a manner which results in uncovered refuse remaining from any previous operating day or at the conclusion of any operating day, unless authorized by permit.

A violation of Section 21(o)(5) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(5)) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to provide daily cover to the site.**

5. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.106(a), a uniform layer of at least 0.15 meter (six inches) of clean soil material shall be placed on all exposed waste by the end of each day of operation.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.106(a) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to provide daily cover to the site.**

The following new violations were observed and are indicated on the accompanying checklist.

1. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(1)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit granted by the Agency or in violation of any conditions imposed by such permit.

A violation of Section 21(d)(1) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3 failed to comply with the following condition of Permit Number 1994-105-LFM.**

II. Operating Conditions

2. **The operator of this solid waste facility shall not conduct the operation in a manner which results in any of the following.**
 1. **Failure to collect and contain litter from the site by the end of each operating day**

Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to collect and contain litter by the end of each operating day.

2. Pursuant to Section 21(o)(12) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(12)), no person shall conduct a sanitary landfill operation which is required to have a permit under subsection (d) of this Section in a manner which results in failure to collect and contain litter from the site by the end of each operating day.

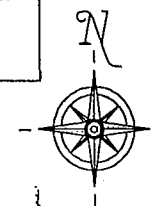
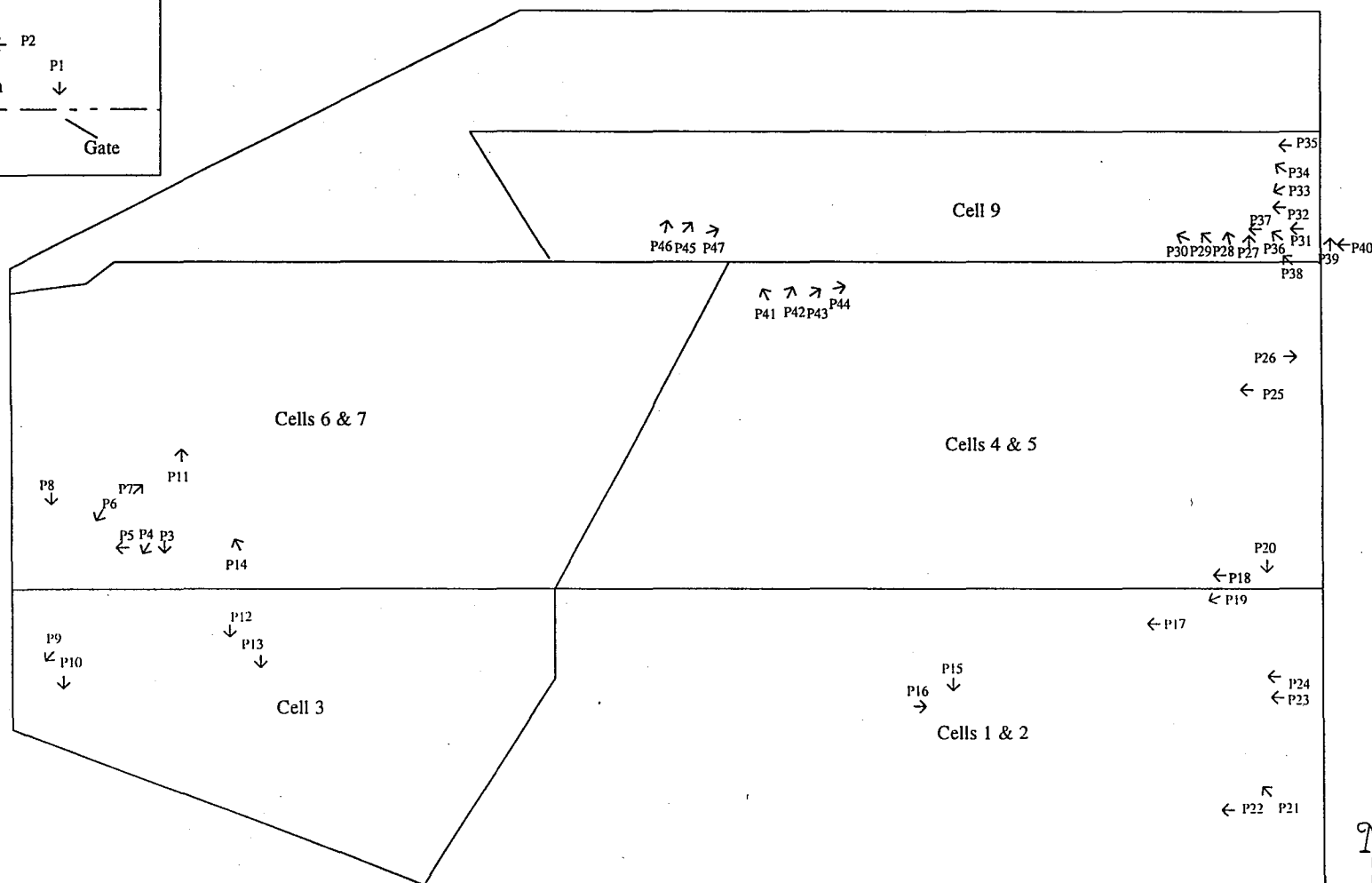
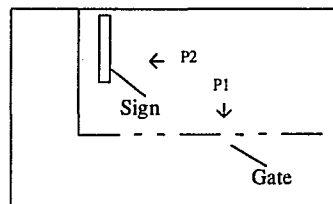
A violation of Section 21(o)(12) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(o)(12)) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to collect and contain litter by the end of each operating day.**

3. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.107(k)(1), the operator shall patrol the facility daily to check for litter accumulation. All litter shall be collected and placed in the fill or in a secure, covered container for later disposal.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 811.107(k)(1) is alleged for the following reason: **Knox County, as owner and operator of Knox County Landfill #3, failed to check for litter accumulation and ensure that the litter is either placed in the fill or in a secure, covered container for later disposal.**
