ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie and M. Gibson)

On December 7, 2021, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA or Agency) proposed that the Board amend Part 620 of its groundwater quality regulations. *See* 35 Ill. Adm. Code 620. Accompanying the proposal were IEPA’s Statement of Reasons (SR), a motion for acceptance, the proposed amendments, and other documents.

The Board finds that IEPA’s proposal satisfies the content requirements (35 Ill. Adm. Code 102.202) and accepts the proposal for hearing. IEPA’s motion for acceptance is granted. The Board directs its assigned hearing officer to schedule and proceed to hearing under the rulemaking provisions of the Environmental Protection Act and the Board’s procedural rules (415 ILCS 5/27, 28 (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 102). After conducting hearings on IEPA’s proposal, the Board will determine whether to proceed to first notice.
