Burbank S & K Realty, Inc. and Star Relax Station, Inc., d/b/a Burbank Gas (Air – Enforcement)</u> – The Board accepted the People’s complaint for hearing concerning Burbank S&K Realty and Star Relax Station’s gasoline dispensing facility located in Cook County.	4-0 roll call vote Gibson abstained
