
ORDER OF THE BOARD (by J. Van Wie):

On January 6, 2022, the parties timely filed an amended request to extend the 35-day period within which Farmers State Bank of Alto Pass (FSB) may appeal a December 14, 2021 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA).¹ The determination concerns interim hazardous waste management units owned by FSB and located in Marion, Williamson County. The IEPA determined that it cannot approve FSB’s Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Closure Plan because of specified deficiencies.

The Board extends the appeal period until Monday, May 2, 2022 as the parties’ request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2020); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If FSB fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
