#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Now Comes the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), through its attorneys, and pursuant to Section 125.204 of the Illinois Pollution Control Board's ("Board") regulations, files the following Recommendation regarding the tax certification of air pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- On July 10, 2003, the Illinois EPA received a request from Ameren Energy Generating Company for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of air pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204, and noted the request as log number TC-03-07-10. (Exhibit A).

- The air pollution control facilities in this request are located at R.R. 1, Box 306, Coffeen,

  Montgomery County and consist of the following:

Selective Catalytic Reduction system whose principal purpose is to reduce emissions of Nitrogen Oxides from steam generating unit CB-1. Because the primary purpose of this system is to reduce or eliminate air pollution, it is certified as a pollution control facility.

- 4. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2000), defines "pollution control facilities" as: "any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: (a) eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution ...or (b) treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property."
- 5. Pollution control facilities are entitled to preferential tax treatment, 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2000).
- Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facilities, to prevent, eliminate or reduce air pollution, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing air pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200. Therefore, the facilities are eligible for tax certification from the Board.
- 7. Therefore, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

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#### AGENCY RECOMMENDATION

The Agency states that it received a tax certification application from Dynegy Midwest on September 16, 2002. Agency Recommendation (Agency Rec.) at 1. On March 31, 2003, the Agency filed a recommendation on the application with the Board. The Agency's recommendation identifies the facilities at issue: Refurbishment of Flue Gas Conditioning SO<sub>3</sub> System, Unit 2. Agency Rec. at 1. The Agency's recommendation further describes the facilities: to convert a portion of the SO<sub>2</sub> in the flue gas to SO<sub>3</sub>, which reduces fly ash and improves the performance of the electrostatic precipitator. *Id.* at 1-2. The Agency's recommendation also identifies the location of the facilities: R.R. #1, Box 200AA, Hennepin, Putnam County. *Id.* at 1.

The Agency recommends that the Board certify that the identified facilities are pollution control facilities as defined in Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2002)) because the primary purpose of the facilities is eliminating, preventing, or reducing air pollution. Agency Rec. at 2.

#### TAX CERTIFICATE

The Board finds and certifies that Dynegy Midwest's facilities identified in this order are pollution control facilities under the Property Tax Code. 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2002). Under Section 11-25 of the Property Tax Code, the effective date of this certificate is "the date of application for the certificate or the date of the construction of the facility, whichever is later." 35 ILCS 200/11-25 (2002); see also 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.216(a). Section 125.216(d) of the Board's procedural rules states that the Clerk "will provide the applicant and the Agency with a copy of the Board's order setting forth the Board's findings and certificate, if any." 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.216(d) (quoting in italics 35 ILCS 200/11-30 (2002)). The Clerk therefore will provide Dynegy Midwest and the Agency with a copy of this order.

#### IT IS SO ORDERED.

Section 41(a) of the Environmental Protection Act provides that final Board orders may be appealed directly to the Illinois Appellate Court within 35 days after the Board serves the order. 415 ILCS 5/41(a) (2002); see also 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(d)(2), 101.906, 102.706. Illinois Supreme Court Rule 335 establishes filing requirements that apply when the Illinois Appellate Court, by statute, directly reviews administrative orders. 172 Ill. 2d R. 335. The Board's procedural rules provide that motions for the Board to reconsider or modify its final orders may be filed with the Board within 35 days after the order is received. 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101,520; see also 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.902, 102.700, 102.702.
