- 1 HEARING OFFICER HALLORAN: Good morning everyone.
- 2 My name is Bradley Halloran. I am a hearing officer
- 3 with the Illinois Pollution Control Board. I'm also
- 4 assigned to this matter entitled Citizens Against
- 5 Landfill Expansion, Petitioner, versus American Disposal
- 6 Services of Illinois, Inc., and Livingston County Board,
- 7 with the corresponding Board number PCB 03-236. And
- 8 this matter is continued on record from yesterday,
- 9 September 8th, 2003. Today is September 9th, 2003.
- 10 It's my understanding -- and I'll let the
- 11 parties introduce themselves and state their position.
- 12 It's my understanding that the parties are close to
- 13 resolving this issue. I guess there are a few
- 14 settlement terms that need to be ironed out. Is it fair
- 15 to say, Ms. Gerwin, that you are optimistic that the
- 16 motion to withdraw will be filed by or before 4:30
- 17 today?
- MS. GERWIN: Yes.
- 19 HEARING OFFICER HALLORAN: Okay. Thank you. With
- 20 that said, Ms. Gerwin, would you like to introduce
- 21 yourself just for the record.
- MS. GERWIN: Yes. My name is Carolyn Gerwin. I
- 23 represent Citizens Against Landfill Expansion, the
- 24 petitioner in this matter. And we would be moving for

- 1 adjournment of this hearing until tomorrow at 8 a.m., if
- 2 necessary.
- 3 HEARING OFFICER HALLORAN: Thank you.
- 4 Mr. Lee.
- 5 MR. LEE: Thank you, Mr. Hearing Officer. My name
- 6 is Douglas Lee. I represent American Disposal Services
- 7 of Illinois, Inc., and we would join in Ms. Gerwin's
- 8 motion.
- 9 HEARING OFFICER HALLORAN: County Board.
- 10 MR. CLARK: Larry Clark on behalf of Livingston
- 11 County Board along with Thomas Blakeman. The County
- 12 stands ready and able to go forward with this. We do
- 13 not join in the motion. We are ready for the hearing,
- 14 Mr. Hearing Officer. And we would ask that the
- 15 petitioner call their witnesses.
- 16 HEARING OFFICER HALLORAN: Okay. When you say you
- 17 will not join in the motion, the motion to withdraw?
- 18 MR. CLARK: The motion to continue.
- 19 HEARING OFFICER HALLORAN: Okay. All right.
- 20 MR. BLAKEMAN: We are prepared to proceed right
- 21 now.
- 22 HEARING OFFICER HALLORAN: Okay. Thank you. And,
- 23 Mr. Blakeman, I neglected to introduce you yesterday.
- 24 But Mr. Blakeman was here on September 8th for the

- 1 County, yesterday; and he is here today.
- With that said, and based on the County's
- 3 representation, we definitely need to go forward
- 4 tomorrow morning at 8 a.m. if this matter does not get
- 5 resolved because we only have two days left and that's
- 6 it. And we will do the posthearing briefs and the
- 7 record closes.
- 8 If there are no other comments or questions
- 9 or issues -- by the way, the County's motion is denied,
- 10 and we will take it up tomorrow morning. Presumably,
- 11 the petitioners will file a motion to withdraw, and the
- 12 Board will accept that by fax with hard copies to
- 13 follow.
- 14 With that said, this hearing is adjourned and
- 15 stayed and continued until tomorrow morning at 8 a.m.,
- 16 September 10th. And if a motion to withdraw is not
- 17 filed by today, then the petitioners are asked to be
- 18 ready to call their first witness tomorrow by 8 a.m.
