The Clerk of the Board called the roll. The Chair and Members Gibson and Van Wie, all of whom were physically present in Room 11-512, answered present. The Chair then made a motion under Section 7(a)(iii) of the Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/7(a)(iii) (2020)) for Member Palivos to attend the meeting telephonically as she was prevented from physically attending because of a family emergency. The Chair's motion was approved by a roll call vote of 3-0, after which Member Palivos answered present. The Chair then made a motion under Section 7(a)(i) of the Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/7(a)(i) (2020)) for Member Santos to attend the meeting telephonically as she was prevented from physically attending because of personal illness. The Chair's motion was approved by a roll call vote of 4-0, after which Member Santos answered present.

<u>AS 21-1</u>	<p><u>Petition of Midwest Generation, LLC for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code 845.740(a) and a Finding of Inapplicability of 35 Ill. Adm Code 845 (Joliet 29 Station)</u> (Land) The Board granted Midwest Generation’s unopposed motion to withdraw its request for a hearing on its petition for an adjusted standard as to Ponds 1 and 3 at its Joliet 29 Station in Will County. The Board’s ruling leaves Pond 2 as the subject of the scheduled hearing on Midwest Generation’s petition.</p>	5-0 roll call vote

<u>PCB 22-31</u>	<p><u>People of the State of Illinois v. Bel-Rock Asphalt Paving, Inc.</u> (Water, NPDES – Enforcement) Upon receiving a stipulation, a proposed settlement, and an agreed motion for relief from the hearing requirement in this enforcement action involving a Boone County asphalt-paving, sealcoating, pavement-stripping, and pothole-repair facility, the Board directed the Clerk to provide the required newspaper notice.</p>	4-0 roll call vote (Gibson abstained)
<u>PCB 22-44</u>	<p><u>Minit Mart, LLC v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (UST Appeal) Because Minit Mart failed to file a petition for review during the extended appeal period, the Board dismissed the case and closed the docket.</p>	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-78</u>	<p><u>Klingler Cattle 1 v. Illinois Environmental Protection Agency</u> (Water – Tax Certification) The Board found and certified that Klingler Cattle 1’s livestock waste management facilities located in Hancock County are pollution control facilities for preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2020)).</p>	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-79</u>	<p><u>People of the State of Illinois v. Curless Flying Service, Inc. and Farm Air, Inc.</u> (Air – Enforcement) The Board accepted for hearing the People’s complaint concerning Curless’ aerial application of pesticides in DeWitt County using aircraft owned by Farm Air.</p>	5-0 roll call vote

<u>PCB 22-80</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. Ibrahim Mubarak</u> (Air – Enforcement) The Board accepted for hearing the People’s complaint concerning Mr. Mubarak’s gas station in Cook County.	5-0 roll call vote
<u>PCB 22-81</u>	<u>People of the State of Illinois v. Az Spe, LLC</u> (Air – Enforcement) The Board accepted for hearing the People’s complaint concerning Az Spe’s two gas stations in Cook County.	5-0 roll call vote


OTHER ITEMS
