RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") hereby files its Recommendation pursuant to Section 125.204 of the regulations of the Illinois Pollution Control Board ("Board"), 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.

- On April 11, 2022, the Illinois EPA received a request from LC Family Farms Taylor Ridge (log number TC-146255, Exhibit A) for an Illinois EPA recommendation regarding the tax certification of water pollution control facilities pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.204.
- 2. The facility's address is: LC Family Farms

The proposed water pollution control facilities in this request are located in the SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 16-North, Range 3-West of the 4th PM in Rock Island County, at the above street address and consist of the following:

Livestock waste management facilities consisting of one (1) concrete livestock waste pit measuring 391 ft. (length) x 51 ft. (width) x 8 ft. (depth) with 10 concrete pump out pits approximately 6 ft. (length) x 5 ft. (width) x 8 ft. (depth) and approximately 884 linear feet of 4 inch diameter perimeter drain tile and approximately 19,941 sq. ft. of concrete slatted flooring over this manure pit.

These livestock waste management facilities are used to collect, transport, and/or store livestock waste prior to cropland application, and are further described in Exhibit A.

3. Section 11-10 of the Property Tax Code, 35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2020), and Section 125.200(a) of the Board's regulations, 35 III. Adm. Code 125.200(a), define "pollution control facilities" as:

any system, method, construction, device or appliance appurtenant thereto or any portion of any building or equipment, that is designed, constructed, installed or operated for the primary purpose of: eliminating, preventing, or reducing air or water pollution...or treating, pretreating, modifying or disposing of any potential solid, liquid or gaseous pollutant which if released without treatment, pretreatment modification or disposal might be harmful, detrimental or offensive to human, plant or animal life, or to property.

- 4. In order to receive preferential tax treatment as pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/11-5 (2020), pollution control facilities must be certified as such by the Board, 35 ILCS 200/11-20 (2020) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a).
- 5. Upon receipt of a tax certification application, the Illinois EPA must file a recommendation on the application with the Board, 35 Ill Adm. Code 125.204(a).
- 6. Based on the information in the application and the purpose of the facility, it is the Illinois EPA's engineering judgment that the described facilities may be considered "pollution control facilities," pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200(a), with the primary purpose of eliminating, preventing, or reducing water pollution, or as otherwise provided in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 125.200, and are eligible for tax certification from the Board.

WHEREFORE, the Illinois EPA recommends that the Board issue the requested tax certification.

One wean to finish hog building measuring (51"x391'x8 deep pit) Building consist of a concrete foundation and concrete slatted floors over 100% of the 51"x391"x8" deep pit. A finished grade around the building prevents fresh water from entering the pit .Manure storge is adequate enough to contain 14 months of manure production which will safely protect the well and nearby crop from contamination. An inspection port 8" deep and 8" in diameter is used to monitor the perimeter tile around the building and soil near the pit area. Manure from the pits will be pumped annually and applied by sub surface injection at an appropriate rate to cropland nearby.




