
HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On August 26, 2022, the respondent, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA), filed a motion for extension of time to file the record on appeal (Mot.). The IEPA states that due to “business constraints” it was unable to complete the record by the August 17, 2022, due date. Mot. at 1. The IEPA reports that the parties are at present involved in “negotiations to resolve disputed issues.” *Id.* at 2. Finally, respondent states that the petitioner has no objection to the motion to extend. *Id.*

IEPA requests that the record due date be extended to and including October 17, 2022. *Id.* The IEPA’s motion is granted and the record on appeal is now due to be filed on or before October 17, 2022, or until the hearing officer or Board orders otherwise. **IEPA’s motion is granted, contingent upon petitioner’s filing of an additional waiver of the statutory decision deadline to January 5, 2023**, which it said it would at the August 25, 2023, telephonic status conference.

The parties or their legal representatives are directed to participate in a telephonic status conference with the hearing officer on September 22, 2022, at 1:30 p.m. The telephonic status conference must be initiated by the petitioner, and provide a call-in number, but each party is nonetheless responsible for its own appearance. At the status conference, the parties must be prepared to discuss the status of the above-captioned matter and their readiness for hearing.


