The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (“Illinois EPA”) has reviewed your August 8, 2022 request for a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b). Based on this review, a provisional variance for a period of 30-days is **GRANTED** by the Illinois EPA.


The applicable facts of this request are as follows:

1. Unforeseen circumstances that resulted in this request is due to the Heritage East Liverpool, Ohio incinerator being shut down to perform routine maintenance on June 26th, 2022.
2. During this shutdown, the facility experienced a non-waste related fire. This led to damage of critical equipment which must be repaired before the incinerator can safely come back online
3. The 90-day accumulation period for the various wastes are listed on the attached letter from Aldrich-APL LLC.

35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b) allows a generator to seek an extension of up to 30 days by means of a provisional variance from the Illinois EPA if hazardous waste must remain on-site for longer than 90 days due to unforeseen, temporary, and uncontrollable circumstances. The Illinois EPA finds that such facts and circumstances exist in this situation and hereby **GRANTS** a provisional variance pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b) for a period of 30 days.

The Illinois EPA grants this provisional variance in accordance with its authority contained in Sections 35(b), 36 (c), and 37(b) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/35(b), 36(c), and 37(b)) and 35 Ill. Adm. Code 722.117(b). The decision to grant this provisional variance is not intended to address compliance with any other applicable laws or regulations.

Dear Sir or Madam:

Due to unforeseen circumstances regarding our waste vendor *Heritage Thermal Services* incinerator shutdown, we are requesting a 30-day extension of the 90-day maximum accumulation for Large Quantity Generators. One 5-gallon drum of *Organic Lab Solvents* has a 90-day date of **8/11/22** (with the EPA provisional variance) and the waste pick up has not been scheduled as we are looking for additional avenues to properly dispose of this material. We will need an additional 30-day extension on this waste stream.

In addition to the waste stream mentioned, we have the following waste streams with approaching 90-day maximum dates:

- Spent Carbon- 1) 55 gal. DF with a 90-day date of 9/13/22
- Cyclohexane- 1 qty.) 55 gal. DF with a 90-day date of 9/03/22
- Bromine 3 qty.) PIH CF with a 90-day date of 8/20/22, 9/1/22, & 9/10/22
- Lead Oxide Production Waste 3 qty.) 55 gal. DF with a 90-day date of 9/17/22
- Cobalt II oxalate waste 1 qty.) 55 gal. DF with a 90-day date of 9/17/22

Dear Customer:

The purpose of this letter is to provide an update on the Heritage Thermal Services incinerator in East Liverpool, Ohio. On June 27, after we had taken the incinerator offline and had been performing maintenance activities for several days, a non-waste related fire developed in the air pollution control equipment. Thankfully, no injuries were sustained. Due to this unforeseen event and resulting extended outage, we are unable to accept waste into the facility until repairs are completed. Your sales and customer experience professionals will continue to work with you to cancel or reschedule your waste shipments.

Our employees have worked tirelessly since June 27 to evaluate the facility, source replacement equipment, and begin repairs. We are currently targeting resumption of waste acceptance and incineration activities in early to mid-November 2022.

We plan to schedule your waste for incineration as soon as we can safely and compliantly do so. We can assist with your 30-day extension letters and provide letters from US EPA and available state agency authored letters regarding capacity, if needed.
