RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE RECORD

NOW COMES, Brenda Mathis, duly appointed State's Attorney for Fayette County, Illinois, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.116(a), hereby moves for an extension of time until January 6, 2022 in which to file Fayette County's record for this appeal. In support of this motion, the Respondent states as follows:

1. On December 1, 2022, the Illinois Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as "Board") ordered Fayette County to file the entire record of its determination by December 22, 2022, unless the Board or hearing officer orders otherwise. Order of the Board, page 2 (December 1, 2022).
2. The previous State's Attorney, Joshua Morrison, was elected as Resident Circuit Judge and took office on December 5, 2022.
3. The current State's Attorney, Brenda Mathis, was appointed to State's Attorney on December 3, 2022 and took office on December 5, 2022.
4. The current State's Attorney is currently reviewing the relevant documents for the purposes of filing the record.
5. Due to the magnitude of the record, it is taking additional time to review and prepare the record for filing with the Board.

6. Respondent conferred with Petitioner, and Petitioner is amendable to the extension of time to file the record by January 6, 2022.

7. Based on the foregoing, Respondent requests an extension of time until January 6, 2023 to file the entire record with the Board.

WHEREFORE, for reasons stated herein, Respondent respectfully requests that the Board hearing officer enter an order granting the Respondent's motion to extend the deadline for Respondent to file the record until January 6, 2023.
