

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

On November 15, 2001, the Board, at the parties' request, extended until February 3, 2002, the time period within which the City of Springfield (City) may appeal an October 1, 2001 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) regarding the amended high priority site investigation corrective action plan. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40 (a)(1) (2000); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. Springfield's facility is located in Sangamon County. Because the City failed to timely file an appeal, the Board dismisses this case and closes the docket.
