NOTICE OF HEARING The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearing regarding a rulemaking proposed by the Illinois IEPA on December 7, 2022: Proposed Amendments to 35 III. Adm. Code 201, 202, and 212 December 2, 202, and and 212 Docket R23-18. If adopted by the Board, the Illinois EPA will submit the proposed amendments to 35 III. Adm. Code Parts 201, 202, and 212 to the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("USEPA") review and approval as a revision to Illinois' State State Implementation Plan ("SIP") regarding startup, malfunction, and breakdown events. The revisions submit-ted to USEPA include removal of Sections 201.261, 201.262, and 201.265, which were identified as inconsistent with the Clean Air Act in USEPA's 2015 Startup, Shutdown, and Malfunction SIP Call. Additionally, the SIP submittal will contain amendments to other sections of the Administrative Code arising from the removal of those three provisions, including removal of Sections 201.263 and 201.264, and amendments to Sections 201.149, 201.157, 201.301, 202.107, 202.211, 212.124, and 212.324. These amendments remove references to provisions removed from the SIP and provide clarification. This notice is intended to satisfy the requirements of satisty the requirements of Clean Air Act Section 110(1), 42 U.S.C. § 7410(1) (public notice for SIP revisions). The Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, January 19, 2023, beginning at 9:00 AM at the Illinois Pollution Control Roard Conference Control Board Conference Room, First Floor, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, (North Entrance) Springfield, Illinois. The second is scheduled for Thursday, February 16, 2023, beginning at 9:00 AM at the Michael A. Bilandic Building Room N 505, Chicago, Illinois. An additional hearing is also scheduled for Thursday, March 2, 2023, beginning at 9:00 AM at the Illinois Pollution Control Board Conference Room, First Floor, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, (North Entrance) Spring-field, Illinois. The hearings are subject to cancellation without notice and may be confirmed by calling the Office of the Clerk at 312/814-3461. A copy of the proposal for public comment is available for public inspection on Board's website at https://pcb.illinois.gov/. and at the Office of Clerk of the Pollution Control Illinois Board, 60 East Van Buren, Suite 630, Chicago, Illinois 60605.
