ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On February 9, 2018, the Forrest Land Trust timely filed a petition asking the Board to review a January 5, 2018 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). The Agency's determination concerns the Forrest Land Trust's leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at 402 West Howard Street in Pontiac, Livingston County. On February 22, 2018, the Board accepted the petition for hearing.

On February 23, 2023, the Forrest Land Trust filed a motion to dismiss (Mot.). The motion states that the Forrest Land Trust "no longer seeks to appeal" the determination and requests that the Board dismiss this matter. Mot. at 1. The Board grants the Forrest Land Trust's motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
