ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.F. Currie)

On May 4, 2023, the Board adopted final amendments to its rules on public water supplies, 35 Ill. Adm. Code Subtitle F. The full text of the amendments was located in an addendum to that order. See In the Matter of: Amendments to 35 Ill Adm. Code Subtitle F: Public Water Supply, R18-26 (May 4, 2023) (Addendum). In that addendum, under Section 601.103(b)(3), the Board incorrectly listed the first sentence as follows:

- 3) Concentrations of constituents in finished water must not exceed the secondary MCLs listed in the following chart: should not be exceeded in the finished water.

Instead, the beginning of 601.101(b)(3) should have read as follows:


- 3) Concentrations of constituents listed in the following chart should not be exceeded in the finished water.

In a public comment, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency noted the error (PC #16). After considering this clerical error, as well as non-substantive discrepancies between the Board's rule text and that of the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, the Board modifies the addendum *nunc pro tunc*, as indicated in the corrected addendum dated May 4, 2023, accompanying this order.

The Board filed the correct rule text with the Secretary of State, which will be published in the *Illinois Register*.
