The Illinois Pollution Control Board gives notice of public hearing regarding rule

changes proposed by the Board on July 6, 2023: National Ambient Air Quality Standards, USEPA Amendments (July 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022), R23-15. If adopted by the Board, the Illinois EPA will submit the proposed amendments to 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 243.108 to the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("USEPA") for review and approval as a revision to Illinois' SIP. The revisions submitted to USEPA include incorporation of the new List of Designated Reference and Equivalent Methods. This notice is intended to satisfy the requirements of Clean Air Act Section 110(1), 42 U.S.C. § 7410(l) (public notice for SIP revisions).

The update is needed to ensure that Illinois' regulations reflect the USEPA's most recent NAAQS. Interested persons are invited to attend the hearings or to submit written comments. The Public Hearing will be held on August 17, 2023, at 11:30 a.m. at the James R. Thompson Center, 100 West Randolph Street, Room 16-504, Chicago, Illinois and the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Building, Illinois Pollution Control Board Hearing Room, Room 1244N, First Floor 1021 North Grand Avenue East, Springfield, Illinois. The hearing is subject to cancellation without notice and may be confirmed by calling the Office of the Clerk at 312/814-3461. 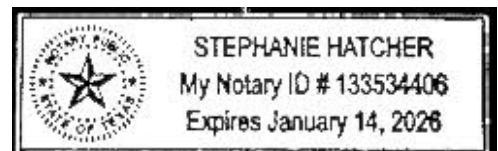
