I HEARING OFFICER HANDZEL: I will call the hearing to order. I am Elizabeth Handzel, the stand-in Hearing Officer for this proceeding. This is PCB 91-17, B. F. Goodrich versus the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. This is an appeal of permit conditions. And the regular Hearing Officer has been detained for some reason, so I am stepping in.

I believe I will let the parties take over now.

MR. KISSEL: My name is Richard Kissel, I represent the petitioner in this matter. To my left is Lisa Anderson, who is with the same firm, Gardner, Carton & Douglas.

This was to be the second day of hearing on this matter. Since the last hearing on November 19th, representatives of B. F. Goodrich and the Agency have met and have discussed a resolution of this matter.

We actually met last Thursday, the 12th of December in Springfield. As a result of

that meeting the Agency and B. F. Goodrich have reached what he believe is a settlement proposal and decided that since we were close to resolving this matter that it would be fruitless to have a hearing and the expense to do so.

So we called the Hearing Officer, Mr. Sikes. Lisa called him on Thursday and advised him of that, and he was in agreement as long as we, we meaning B. F. Goodrich, would provide the Board with a waiver of the decision date, which we will do. We have been doing it by dates certain, and we will do that. We will provide the Board with a date.

Basically, we are asking the Board to suspend the hearings in this matter. We will come forward with written documents, et cetera, which will describe the nature of the resolution and we will request specific action of the Board at that time.

MS. MORENO: My name is Lisa Moreno, I am here representing the Illinois Environmental

1 Protection Agency. And as Mr. Kissel has just recounted, we met on Thursday and have come to a resolution which the Agency believes is in the best interest of the environment in this case.

As Mr. Kissel has indicated, further papers will be filed with the Board which will continue this settlement process which we began on Thursday.

HEARING OFFICER HANDZEL: Off the record, please.

(Discussion had off the record.)

HEARING OFFICER HANDZEL: On the record. That's it. Thank you very much. There were no members of the public.
