ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Dr. Satchell):

On June 15, 1979 Chambers, Bering, Quinlan Company (CBQ) filed a variance petition requesting relief from the special waste manifest requirements of Chapter 9: Special Waste Hauling Regulations. The petition is subject to the same deficiencies as those noted in the Board's Order of this date in Wagner Casting Company (Wagner) v. EPA, PCB 79-124. In addition, CBQ has advised the Board in a pleading filed September 17, 1979 that it has been purchased by Wagner. It is unclear whether Wagner intended to join in this petition or CBQ to join in PCB 79-124. It is also unclear whether CBQ continues to exist as a separate entity and whether one variance or two are now requested.

The petition is dismissed.
