# MOTION TO DISMISS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

NOW COMES the Complainant, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA"), by and through its attorney, Special Assistant Attorney General Michelle M. Ryan, pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.402, and respectfully states as follows:

(1) On December 15, 2003, the Illinois EPA issued an Administrative Citation to Respondent Charles L. Parker, based on an inspection conducted on November 10, 2003.

(2) On January 5, 2004, the Administrative Citation was sent back to the Illinois EPA from the United States Postal Service, as unclaimed.
