ORDER OF THE BOARD (by M.D. Mankowski):


On May 25, 2021, Brandis Aircraft filed a petition for review of an April 21, 2021 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). In that determination, IEPA denied a Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) certification of closure for Brandis Aircraft’s refurbishing and repair facility in Taylorville, Christian County.

On February 6, 2024, Brandis Aircraft filed motion for voluntary dismissal (Mot.). The motion reports that the parties have resolved all issues raised by the petition and that Brandis Aircraft “seeks no further relief from the Board in this matter.” Mot. at 1. The motion adds that IEPA does not object to granting the motion. *Id.*

The Board grants the unopposed motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses this case, and closes the docket.
